Delete Users:

1. Login to your WordPress Dashboard:

2. Access the Users Section:

o In the left sidebar, find and click on "Users."

3. View All Users:

• Click on "All Users" to see a list of all users on your site.

4. Select the User to Delete:


- Hover over the user you want to delete, and you'll see options like "Edit," "Delete," etc.

6. What Happens When a User is Deleted:

- Deleting a user removes their access to the site. However, it does not delete the content they have created (e.g., posts, pages).
- \circ Any content created by the deleted user will usually be attributed to the user with the role "Deleted User."
