

# WordPress - Delete Pages

To delete pages in WordPress, you can follow these steps:

## 1. Login to your WordPress Dashboard:

- Open your web browser and go to the login page of your WordPress site.
- Enter your username and password to log in.

## 2. Navigate to the Pages Section:

- Once logged in, you'll be on the Dashboard. Look for the "Pages" option on the left sidebar.

Always double-check and make sure you are deleting the correct page, especially if it contains important content.
